On Friday, September 02, 2016, at 1408 hours, I, Charles Johnston, was dispatched to 129 E Jackson St (Apollo Records) in reference to a dispute. The shop owner, Patti Smith, said that she was in a dispute with a customer who just left the store. Smith said there were two parents and three children in total. Smith told me that the wife cussed at her and threatened to leave bad reviews about her shop online. Smith said the dispute started because the children were on some of the furniture in the store.

I found the family at Grassroots Coffee (116 S Broad St). I spoke to the father, Seann Frazier, who told me that the argument started because the shop owner yelled at his children for being on the furniture. He said he and his family left the shop and the owner followed them down the street yelling at them. I told Frazier that Smith did not want them back at 129 E Jackson St. He told me not to worry because they would not return.

I returned to Smith who said she wanted to press charges in reference to a poor internet review. I told her that was a civil issue. I also let her know that I spoke with the father of the family and told them not to return to her business.
