On February 20, 2024, the Leon County Board of County Commissioners approved the adoption of a resolution acknowledging and apologizing for the history of slavery and racism in Leon County. The resolution underscores Leon County's unwavering dedication to advancing equality and ensuring the protection of the fundamental rights of individuals regardless of race, color, religion, or national origin. Leon County is committed to recognizing the misdeeds suffered by African Americans during the eras of slavery and Jim Crow and to working toward eliminating racial prejudices, injustices, and discrimination from our society.
